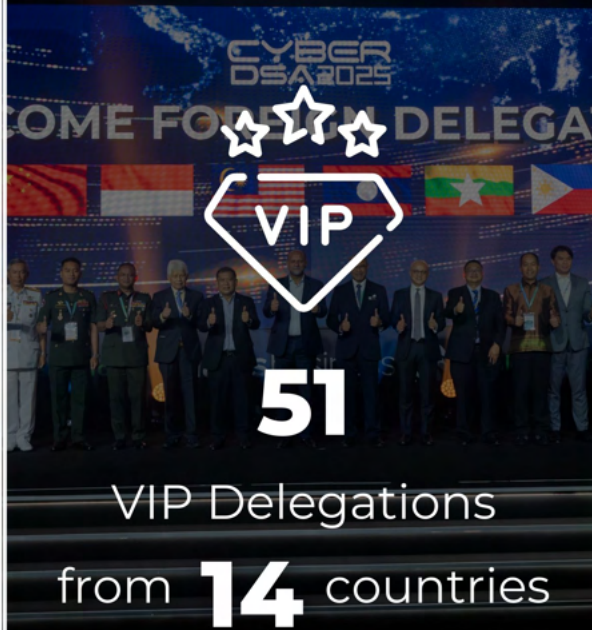

# HAPPENING AT CYBERDSA 2025

## SIBER SIAGA 2025

Happening alongside CyberDSA 2025, Siber Siaga 2025 was an awareness programme organised by the **Defence Cyber and Electromagnetic Division (DCED)** of the Malaysian Armed Forces. Officiated on 1 October 2025 by Deputy Minister of Defence, YB Adly bin Zahari, the event continued to advance Malaysia's digital resilience agenda by emphasising public participation and youth engagement in cybersecurity.

With activities such as the **Capture the Flag: Code Combat challenge and Piala ESports Gen ATM 2025**, Siber Siaga 2025 highlighted how civil-military collaboration can nurture the next generation of digital defenders. The event also marked the strategic partnership Document Handover between the Malaysian Armed Forces and CyberSecurity Malaysia, reinforcing cooperation in strengthening the nation's cyber readiness.

Under the theme **"Battle Beyond Borders"**, the Siber Siaga Forum brought together experts to discuss evolving cyber threats and defence strategies. The programme concluded with an exhibition tour, showcasing Malaysia's collective commitment toward a safer and more resilient digital future.



## MALAYSIA CYBER SECURITY AWARD

Organised by CyberSecurity Malaysia as part of CyberDSA 2025, the Malaysia Cyber Security Awards celebrated individuals and organisations that have made exceptional contributions to strengthening Malaysia's cyber and information security landscape.

The awards recognised excellence in innovation, leadership, and commitment to advancing the nation's cybersecurity ecosystem. By honouring professionals, homegrown SMEs, and global organisations, the programme continues to inspire collaboration and innovation within Malaysia's dynamic ICT industry.

Malaysia was honoured to once again host the ASEAN Cyber Defence Network (ACDN) Meeting during CyberDSA 2025, reaffirming its commitment to advancing regional cooperation in cyber defence.

The meeting served as a platform for ASEAN member states to strengthen regional cyber capabilities, enhance threat intelligence sharing, and coordinate responses to emerging cyber threats. The 4th ACDN Meeting continued to build on these objectives, fostering a more secure and resilient cyberspace across the ASEAN region.



## FLASH TALK

Short, sharp, and insightful, the Flash Talk Sessions brought together leading voices from the cybersecurity industry to share rapid perspectives on emerging trends, solutions, and strategies.

A total of 22 Flash Talk sessions were delivered by 21 participating companies, each offering actionable insights and forward-looking ideas to strengthen cyber resilience. The sessions attracted a highly engaged audience comprising potential clients, industry professionals, and decision-makers, creating meaningful opportunities for knowledge exchange and business networking.



## CYBER STAGE CONFERENCE

Held across Day 1 to Day 3 of CyberDSA 2025, a total of 21 Cyber Stage Conference sessions were conducted, attracting 609 delegates from government agencies, industry leaders, exhibitors, and visitors.

The sessions provided a dynamic platform for participants to exchange insights, explore forward-looking strategies, and address emerging challenges in digital security. Each discussion fostered meaningful dialogue on trends, innovations, and solutions shaping the cybersecurity landscape. Through these exchanges, CyberDSA 2025 reinforced its role as a catalyst for collaboration, knowledge-sharing, and collective progress toward a more secure digital future.

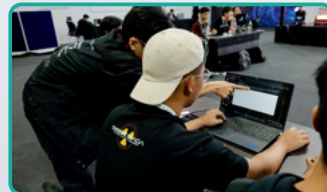


## CAPTURE THE FLAG (CTF)

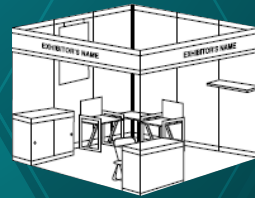

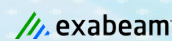
