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CHAIRMAN OF CYBERSECURITY MALAYSIA

A strong digital future requires both advanced technology and a cybersecurity environment that people and organisations can trust. At CyberSecurity Malaysia (CSM), we are committed to strengthening digital trust in practical and measurable ways, so confidence in cyberspace translates into real protection and resilience.

Leveraging on our CyberSecurity Collaboration Program (CSM-CP), we work closely with the National Cyber Security Agency (NACSA) in support of efforts to protect the National Critical Information Infrastructure (NCII). This includes providing trusted cybersecurity certification services, developing industry standards, and supporting training initiatives that improve regional skills and readiness.

As part of its focus on talent development, CSM has trained 19,833 knowledge workers as of April 2026 in key areas including Digital Forensics, Governance, Risk and Compliance, Incident Handling and Response, Cryptography, and Security Assurance. This growing pool of skilled professionals strengthens Malaysia's cyber readiness and reinforces the important role of talent in building national cyber resilience.

At the regional level, CyberSecurity Malaysia continues to build strong partnerships with ASEAN counterparts, including the Cyber Security Agency of Singapore, Indonesia's Badan Siber dan Sandi Negara (BSSN), Cyber Security Brunei, the National Cyber Security Agency of Thailand, and key agencies in Cambodia, Lao PDR, the Philippines, and Timor Leste. These partnerships support stronger cooperation, shared trust, and a more resilient regional cyber environment.

In this spirit of cooperation, CyberDSA 2026, to be held from 5 to 7 October 2026 at the Malaysia International Trade and Exhibition Centre (MITEC), Kuala Lumpur, provides an important platform to turn strategy into practical action. The event brings together policymakers, defence leaders, technology innovators, and cybersecurity professionals to address real challenges in the cyber domain.

CyberDSA is a place where ideas lead to action. By linking strategic priorities with practical solutions, it has become a leading regional platform for cyber defence and digital security. Through this event, we strengthen the cyber talent pipeline, widen information-sharing networks, and support joint research and innovation, all of which are essential to a safer and more resilient digital future.



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Looking ahead, CyberSecurity Malaysia remains committed to supporting a secure, trusted, and inclusive digital environment. Working with partners across government, industry, and academia, we will continue to support digital transformation while ensuring cybersecurity remains a core priority.
